Harriet Greenspan has been a casting director for the past 25 years. Currently, she is making the transition to producing. Harriet and producing partner Mark Kaplan have a slate of movies in development that include the romantic comedy "Stand by Love". Greenspan is also a personal manager and heads the youth division of James Levy, a management company in Los Angeles. Harriet is responsible for discovering and coaching talent such as Anna Sophia Robb (Because of Winn Dixie, Charlie and the Chocolate Factory, The Reaping and Bridge of Terebethia), Matt Underwood (Zoey 101), Bailee Madison (Bridge To Terebethia) and Ryan Malgarini (Gary Unmarried).

Greenspan's casting credits include movies of the week (Shredderman Rules and Last Day of Summer for Nickelodeon), Secret Santa, Miss Lettie and Me, Maniac Magee, To Live Again, Every Woman's Dream, Sahara, Abandoned And Deceived, For The Love Of Nancy). She just completed the casting of "The Clique" (book series) Scooby Doo, The Prequel and Mr. Troop Mom with George Lopez all for Warner Bros and Nickelodeon. She freelances with Nickelodeon casting pilots and series, currently casting Nickelodeon's new hit series "True Jackson, V.P" Other Nickelodeon series were "Ned's Declassified School Survival Guide" and "Unfabulous." Before Nickelodeon, Greenspan was responsible for casting NBC & Spelling produced soap, Sunset Beach. Greenspan was also a casting executive at ABC overseeing the casting on primetime series and pilots such as: Dynasty, Hotel, Bosom Buddies, Hart To Hart, Loveboat, Too Close For Comfort, Benson, Laverne And Shirley, Three's Company and Fantasy Island to name a few.

Preceding ABC, Greenspan was at Lynn Stalmaster and associates where she began her casting career as an associate working on large budgeted features.

Greenspan is also a personal and professional life coach. She also travels all over the country teaching acting to kids and young adults.
